St. Patrick's Day Dispensation from Abstaining

In accord with Canon 87 §1 of the Code of Canon Law, Bishop Folda grants the faithful of the Diocese of Fargo dispensation from the obligation to abstain from eating meat on Friday, **March 17**, St. Patrick's Feast Day. He asks, however, that the faithful perform another suitable penance on that day so as to continue their Lenten preparation for Easter. This dispensation does not apply to the other Fridays of Lent but only to Friday, March 17.
