What is the Catechism of the Catholic Church? Happy 25th Birthday!

On **June 25**, the most recent Catechism of the Church will be 25 years old. On that day Pope John Paul II approved the Catechism, saying that it "...is a statement of the Church's faith and of catholic doctrine, attested to or illumined by Sacred Scripture, the Apostolic Tradition, and the Church's Magisterium. I declare it to be a sure norm for teaching the faith and thus a valid and legitimate instrument for ecclesial communion. May it serve the renewal to which the Holy Spirit ceaselessly calls the Church of God, the Body of Christ, on her pilgrimage to the undiminished light of the Kingdom!"

In light of this anniversary, Fr. Chris encourages all of us to first, buy a Catechism if we don't have one, and second, to read it. It gives an overview of our Faith like no other book, and can answer a lot of questions we may have about our Faith.
