What does the Catechism say about...?

Happy 25th Birthday *Catechism of the Catholic Church!*

“25. How does man respond to God who reveals himself?”

Sustained by divine grace, we respond to God with the obedience of faith, which means the full surrender of ourselves to God and the acceptance of his truth insofar as it is guaranteed by the One who is Truth itself.

26. Who are the principal witnesses of the obedience of faith in the Sacred Scriptures?

There are many such witnesses, two in particular: One is *Abraham* who when put to the test ‘believed God’ (Romans 4:3) and always obeyed his call. For this reason he is called ‘the father of all who believe’ (Romans 4:11). The other is the *Virgin Mary* who, throughout her entire life, embodied in a perfect way the obedience of faith: ‘*Let it be done to me according to your word*’ (Luke 1:38).”
