What does the *Catechism* say about...?

Happy 25th Birthday *Catechism of the Catholic Church!*

“29. Why is there no contradiction between faith and science?”

Though faith is above reason, there can never be a contradiction between faith and science because both originate in God. It is God himself who gives to us the light both of reason and of faith. ‘I believe, in order to understand; and I understand, the better to believe.’ (Saint Augustine)”
